Committed To Serve

he Board of Mid-Valley Women of Christ has committed to serving the Lord by providing prayer times, community-wide Bible studies, and events. The unique circumstances of 2020 have spurred us to adjust how we deliver these life-changing ministries.

When we could not meet in person for prayer times, we hosted a Facebook Live Gathering. Our monthly prayer gatherings at Eastside Christian in Albany, Dallas Foursquare, City of Destiny in Springfield, and River of Life in Sweet Home, are back with appropriate safety measures. We are incredibly grateful to these churches for supporting our ministry by opening their doors.

In September, we launched our 25th community-wide Bible study, "Take Courage" by Jennifer Rothschild. Through courage, 21 host churches are offering 25 classes. They have adapted how they present these sessions to ensure health guidelines are followed. More importantly, ladies can still meet and grow in their faith. There are approximately 400 women from 100 different congregations attending across the valley.

The Fall Community-Wide Praise & Worship Night is adapted as well. This event is scheduled to be live-streamed from Life Community Church in Corvallis. While this is a departure from the usual in-person gathering of over 800 women who crowd the venue, we pray that the Lord will cause this session to reach even more women.

While this year has looked different than we imagined, the Lord of Hosts was not surprised. He has continued to direct and guide our ministry. Thank you for your partnership in this kingdom work!
